

More ABOUT Move IN

ITS VERY IMPORTANT to expedite your move in process by using the e-check in procedures. Please refer to your information from the HOUSING office for instructions

Once you check in you will receive a temporary courtesy card, which you will use to gain access to your buildings until you receive your GWorld card on Monday morning. Depending on the building, you may receive either a swipe card (City Hall, Ivory Tower) or brass keys (New Hall and FSK).

Tips

4. Bring a Hand Truck/Dolly if You Have One
5. Never Leave Belongings Unattended

Green Move-In

At Move-In and throughout the year, GW is committed to sustainability. We encourage you to make Move-In green by taking the following actions

Think about packing items in reusable containers. Consider "buying green" when purchasing items for your room.

We are minimizing the amount of paper handouts you'll receive upon check-in, so plan ahead and print out only the information you'll need upon arrival such as campus maps, directions to your hall and to local stores or restaurants, shopping lists and hub site locations.

If you bring cardboard moving boxes, or have pre-shipped items, break the boxes down and bring them to designated recycling areas (in hall lobbies or outside the hall) or send one or two home with your family for reuse.

GW has a robust recycling program. Do your part by disposing of your water bottles, soda cans and other recyclable materials in the designated receptacles around campus on move-in day and throughout the year.
