prohibited items*

- Candles
- Halogen lamps (including all Halogen desk and floor lamps)
- Incense
- Lanterns/Oil lamps
- Flammable liquids
- Burners and other objects with an open flame in non-kitchen areas
- Hot plates, rice cookers, crock pots, waffle irons and popcorn poppers in non-kitchen areas
- Toasters/Toaster ovens in non-kitchen areas
- George Foreman grills and sandwich makers in non-kitchen areas
- Microwaves or refrigerators that are not provided by the University
- Space heaters
- Live holiday decorations (trees, garlands, etc.)
- Fireworks
- Weapons (including pocket knives, spears, swords, or souvenir weapons)
- Firearms (including pellet, BB, air, or paintball guns)
- Ammunition
- Explosives
- Chemical mace
- Tazers
- Illegal drugs and/or drug paraphernalia
- Alcohol (if underage)

*It is prohibited to tamper with life-safety equipment
(e.g., smoke detectors, sprinklers, etc.)*

**These items will be confiscated and discarded if found.
